Federal Work Study (FWS)

- The FWS Program provides funds for part-time employment to provide need based aid to students to finance the costs of postsecondary education.
- Approximately 3,400 participating postsecondary institutions currently engaged in FWS.
- Hourly wages must <u>NOT</u> be less than the federal minimum wage.
- Financial costs to host organization?

Cooperative Education (Co-op)

- Combines classroom-based learning with practical work experience
- Students earn college credit for structured job experience
- Financial costs to host site?
- Responsibility of the host site?





Internship Programs

- Students get hands-on experience in your organization
- Work Experience Internship
 Students gain experience in their field
- Research based Internship
 - Students do research for your organization
- Financial costs to host site?
