
Activity instructions:

Background: The Problem





CONSORTIUM

Key Findings

- 92% of programs are negatively impacted by flat funding
- 64% are now serving fewer young people
- More than 86% find it more difficult to attract and retain qualified staff

"Most teenage babysitters are requesting \$10 - \$15 per hour to care for a child. There is no expectation that the babysitter will improve the child's academic performance, school attendance, character, or physical fitness level. Yet, ASES grantees ...must achieve these results."

"We have not been able to take our students on a single field trip in over 4 years."




The Solution: AB 2663 (Cooper, D-09)

What will the bill do?

- Adds \$73 million in FY17 to the ASES budget
 raising the daily ASES funding formula from \$7.50 to \$8.50 per student
- Enacts an annual cost of living adjustment to address ongoing future increased costs
